Life at the Academy

Since their training commenced on December 4, 2023, the members of the 173rd Academy Class lived at the Academy during the week, away from family and friends. The days were filled with rigorous physical and mental training, pushing cadets to their limits in a paramilitary environment. They endured continuous pressure to react and perform in a variety of situations, such as intensive college-level training in Ohio laws, misdemeanor and felony arrest techniques, human relations, crash investigation, self-defense tactics, firearms, defensive driving and many other areas.

In addition to the training mentioned above, cadets were expected to perform various individual tasks and assignments around the Academy. They were required to take orders and expected to maintain a high level of professionalism throughout their training. Living in a paramilitary environment required the cadets to pay attention to every detail, including their uniforms and rooms. A daily inspection was conducted to look for infractions like lint on uniforms, shoes not properly shined, dust in rooms, and disorganized wall lockers.
